What The Career Index Plus (TCI+) is:

- A labor market information (LMI) system that,
- Supports meeting WIOA obligation for VR "to ensure that the personnel have a 21st-century understanding of the evolving labor force and the needs of individuals with disabilities" and,
- Is available free of charge to all VR programs and their workforce partners. PP

- Job aids include:
 - A User Manual
 - Targeted TA: Remote assistance with implementation planning.
 - Intensive TA: can be requested when intensive support is indicated.
- Implementation support is based on implementation science.
- 10 regional communities of practice (COP's) for users will be developed.
